## RESOLUTION OF ROCKWOOD BOROUGH COUNCIL

WHEREAS, on March 15, 2005, Rockwood Borough adopted Ordinance No. 2005-2, commonly known as the Coxes Creek Storm Water Management Plan Ordinance, which Ordinance was adopted in order to comply with the directives of Somerset County under Act 167 of October 4, 1978; and

WHEREAS, the Coxes Creek Storm Water Management Plan Ordinance requires certain activities to be made subject to a drainage plan; and

WHEREAS, certain activities are exempted from the requirement of a drainage plan; and WHEREAS, determination of whether or not a drainage plan is necessary requires some review by borough officials; and

WHEREAS, the Coxes Creek Storm Water Management Plan Ordinance allows Borough Council to establish fees for compliance with the said Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, Borough Council deems it advisable to adopt certain fees and other policies in regard to compliance with the Coxes Creek Storm Water Management Plan Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is resolved by Rockwood Borough Council as follows:

- 1. When Rockwood Borough is requested to supply documentation to the Somerset County Planning Commission concerning whether or not plans comply with the Act 167 Storm Water Plan, consultation shall be made with the Borough Solicitor to determine whether or not one of the exceptions apply so that an approval letter may be granted without referral to an engineer or surveyor to allow further review of a drainage plan.
  - 2. The applicant for the approval letter must supply appropriate information to the

Borough, or to the Solicitor, to allow the preliminary review to see if one of the exceptions provided for in Section 4.2 of the Coxes Creek Storm Water Management Plan Ordinance may apply.

- 3. Upon review of that material, if one of the exceptions does apply, the Solicitor may issue a letter to the applicant or to the Planning Commission acknowledging the exception.
- 4. In the above cases, the applicant shall pay a fee to Rockwood Borough in the amount of Fifty and 00/100 (\$50.00) Dollars to cover the expenses involved in the above review.
- 5. If the initial review by the Solicitor reaches a conclusion that one of the exceptions in Section 4.2 of the Coxes Creek Storm Water Management Plan Ordinance does not apply, then the matter shall be reviewed by an engineer or surveyor, and in addition to the fee of Fifty and 00/100 (\$50.00) Dollars as above stated, all costs and expenses shall be borne by the applicant in order to insure compliance with the said Ordinance.
