

ORDINANCE NO. 89-1

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE MAKING IT UNLAWFUL TO MAINTAIN CERTAIN CONDITIONS ON PROPERTY, PROVIDING THE AUTHORITY FOR THE BOROUGH TO INSPECT PREMISES AND TO INVESTIGATE NUISANCES, PROVIDING FOR THE REPORT OF INSPECTIONS AND NOTICE TO ABATE NUISANCES, PROVIDING FOR PROCEEDINGS IN THE CASE OF FAILURE TO OBEY NOTICES TO CORRECT OR ABATE, AND PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF, IDENTIFIED AS ORDINANCE NO. 80-1.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Rockwood, and IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED as follows:

SECTION SEVEN of Ordinance No. 80-1 shall read as follows:

Any person who shall be bound guilty of violation of any of the provisions of this article or guilty of violation of any regulations made under this Ordinance, shall, upon summary conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars nor more than Three hundred (\$300.00) Dollars and may be sentenced to serve ninety (90) days in the Somerset County Jail, or both.
