

ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF ROCKWOOD,
PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING AN ORDINANCE DEFINING
CERTAIN NUISANCES RELATED TO MAINTENANCE OF
PREMISES, EXTERIOR SURFACES AND APPURTENANCES
OF BUILDINGS AND ACCESSORY STRUCTURES AND
PROVIDING FOR THEIR ABATEMENT.

The Council of the Borough of Rockwood, Pennsylvania, pursuant to the specific powers vested in it by The Borough Code, Act of February 1, 1966 (1965 P.O. 1565, No. 481), As Amended, Section 1202, (No. 5), ordains as follows:

SECTION 4. D. of Ordinance 80-1 is hereby amended to read as follows:

General Cleanliness. The accumulation or storage of junk, wood, brick, cement block or other unsightly debris, automobiles or parts thereof, trucks, tractors, refrigerators, furnaces, washing machines, stoves, machinery or parts thereof, such as may tend to depreciate property values in the area or create a nuisance or hazard shall not be allowed on any lot or parcel of land within the corporate limits of the Borough of Rockwood, except when such materials are properly housed and out of public view.
