

ORDINANCE OPENING PORTION OF A PREVIOUSLY LAID
OUT ALLEY AND MAKING SAID ALLEY A STREET AND PART
OF THE PUBLIC STREET SYSTEM OF THE BOROUGH OF
ROCKWOOD, SOMERSET COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

WHEREAS, by virtue of a certain plan of lots laid out by the petitioners in a Petition for Incorporation of the Borough of Rockwood, said plan being recorded in the Somerset County Recorder of Deeds Office in Plan Book Volume 1, page 9, on the 19th day of January, 1885, and said Petition for Incorporation recorded in Deed Book Volume 67, page 433, various streets, alleys and other areas intended for public use were established; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough of Rockwood desires to open and dedicate a street which had previously been known as an alley, for the use of the public which was laid out and established as above mentioned; and,

WHEREAS, the said alley follows a general northeasterly direction from Market Street to Garrett Road and is parallel to Broadway on its Northwest and Main Street on its Southeast; and,

WHEREAS, said alley has been in open and continuous use by the public for more than 21 years; and,

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Borough of Rockwood to change said alley into a street and include said street in the public street system of the Borough of Rockwood and to officially name said street MAPLE AVENUE .

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED THAT:

1. The Borough of Rockwood, Somerset County, Pennsylvania, hereby officially opens a street, formerly an alley, which is hereby described as follows:

Lots Nos. 215 through 241 inclusive adjacent to said alley on its Northwest boundary, and Lots Nos. 66 through 40 inclusive adjacent on its Southeastern boundary. Said alley runs from Market Street North 40° East and intersects with an alley that divides Lots Nos. 217 and 218 on the Northwest and Lots Nos. 64 and 63 on the Southeast; thence continuing with Lots Nos. 218 through 241 on its Northwest and Lots Nos. 63 through 40 on its Southeast, North 28° 30' East through Rock Street and White Oak Street to Garrett Road.

2. The street as described in Section 1 above shall be part of the public street system of the Borough of Rockwood, Somerset County, Pennsylvania, and shall be open to the public.

3. The street as described in Section 1 above shall be officially named Maple Avenue and shall hereafter be known as such.

4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

5. This Ordinance shall take effect 30 days after the enactment hereof.
