

ORDINANCE NO. 2008 - 18-02

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF ROCKWOOD AMENDING CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF ORDINANCE NO. 93-2, WHICH IS COMMONLY REFERRED TO AS THE "ROCKWOOD BOROUGH SEWAGE ORDINANCE" BY DELETING THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 7 (f) AND RATIFYING AND AFFIRMING ALL OTHER PORTIONS OF THE SAID ORDINANCE NOT SO AMENDED.

Be it ORDAINED and ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Rockwood, that

WHEREAS, Council desires to delete any provision in the Sewer Ordinance that a service or "tap-in" lapses if not used for one (1) year or more;

Therefore, it is hereby ORDAINED and ENACTED by the authority of the Council of the Borough of Rockwood as follows:

Section 1.

There is hereby deleted from Ordinance No. 93-2 the provision existing in Section 7 (f) as said provision was specifically added to the Ordinance by the terms of Ordinance No. 97-4 of October 21, 1997.

Section 2.

The intention of this amendment is to delete any provision that a service or "tap-in" not used for one (1) year or more shall lapse and revert to the Borough.

Section 3.



The provisions of this Amendment shall be effective as of January 1, 2008.


