AN ORDINANCE VACATING AN UNNAMED AND UNOPENED ALLEY LYING BETWEEN LOTS NO. 156 AND 157 ON THE GENERAL PLAN OF THE BOROUGH OF ROCKWOOD

WHEREAS, it appears to the Council of the Borough of Rockwood, Somerset County, Pennsylvania, that the unnamed and unopened alley hereinafter described on the General Plan of Rockwood is no longer necessary or convenient for public use or travel, and the said alley should be vacated.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Rockwood, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same:

SECTION 1. Said unnamed and unopened alley, bounded and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the southerly side of Main Street at the northeasterly corner of Lot No. 156 on the General Plan of said Borough; thence along the southerly side of Main Street across the alley to be vacated a distance of 16% feet to the northwesterly corner of Lot No. 157 on said Plan; thence along the westerly side of said Lot No. 157 a distance of 150 feet, more or less, to the end of said Lot No. 157; thence across said alley to be vacated hereby by a line parallel to the southerly side of Main Street a distance of 161/2 feet to the southeasterly corner of Lot No. 156; thence along the easterly side of Lot No. 156 a distance of 150 feet, more or less, to a point on the southerly side of Main Street, the place of beginning. Said unnamed and unopened alley being 161/2 feet in width and 150 feet in length, more or less, and lying between Lots No. 156 and 157 on the General Plan of Rockwood Borough, Somerset County, Pennsylvania; said lots No. 156 and 157 now being owned by Rockwood Fire Department;

be and the same is hereby vacated.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
