

WHEREAS, it appears to the Council of the Borough of Rockwood, Somerset County, Pennsylvania, that the unnamed alley hereinafter described on the General Plan of Rockwood is no longer necessary or convenient for public use or travel, and the said alley should be vacated.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Rockwood, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same:

SECTION 1. Said unnamed alley, bounded and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the northerly side of Main Street at the southwesterly corner of Lot No. 73 on the General Plan of said Borough; thence along the northerly side of Main Street across the alley to be vacated hereby a distance of $16\frac{1}{2}$ feet to a point at the southeasterly corner of Lot No. 74 on said Plan; thence along the easterly side of Lot No. 74 a distance of 150 feet, more or less, to the end of said Lot No. 74 at an unnamed alley that runs parallel to Main Street; thence along the southerly side of said unnamed alley by a line parallel to the said Main Street a distance of $16\frac{1}{2}$ feet to the northwesterly corner of Lot No. 73; thence along the westerly side of Lot No. 73 a distance of 150 feet, more or less, to the end of said Lot No. 73 at the northerly side of Main Street, the place of beginning. Said unnamed alley being $16\frac{1}{2}$ feet in width and 150 feet in length, more or less, and lying between Lot No. 73 and Lot No. 74 on the General Plan of Rockwood Borough, Somerset County, Pennsylvania; said Lots No. 73 and 74 now being owned by Rockwood Insurance Company;

be and the same is hereby vacated.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances
